

Guidelines for the Author(s)

The Indian Journal of Extension Education and Rural Development (IJEERD) is published annually in the month of November-December every year. The scientists, teachers, researchers, students and others may submit the quality research papers based on the original research work in the prescribed format.

- All the authors in the paper must be the Life members of the Society.
- There should not be more than four contributors in a paper.
- The research paper must focus on relevant and important issues/projects/programme related to Extension Education and Rural Development.
- Research paper must be conducted from last five year's research.
- The uniformity in preparation and accuracy, brevity and clarity of style, punctuation, spellings, use of italics, numerical data, calculations, tables etc. is essential.
- Tables should have a clear heading with its serial number and contents.
- Only original research papers will be accepted for publication in the journal.
- The first author, at the time of submission of paper, must confirm that this article or its data has not been sent to any other journal for publication and it has been seen by all the authors.
- The paper must be send through e-mail with a hard copy by post.
- The manuscript must be typed in MS Word only.

Guidelines for full length paper

The Research Papers should be subdivided into following sections:

Title

Name of authors (without using Dr./Er./Mr./Mrs. Etc).

Footnote with full details of designation and official address of each author.

Abstract

Introduction (Note more than 200 words)

Research Methodology

Results and Discussions

Conclusion (Note more than 100 words)

References

The detailed information is as follows:

TITLE

The title of the paper/article should be relevant to the contents of the research study. It should be short, specific and informative including typed in Times New Roman 12 sized font.

AUTHOR/AUTHORS

The name(s) of author(s) should be clearly typed in title case letters. The e-mail address and mobile number must be mentioned clearly.

FOOTNOTE

The details of designation and official address of each author must be given at footnote on first page.

ABSTRACT

A brief and factual summary or salient point of the research outcome and the conclusions of the investigation reported in the paper must be given in Abstract. It must be brief and should not include data. Only a narration of the outcome of research may be given. The abstract should be concise as much as possible and not exceed 250 words in length.

INTRODUCTION

This section should introduce the subject of the research paper including a brief statement of the problem, justifying the need for doing the work or the hypothesis on which the work is based, the findings of other researchers which may be further developed or challenged and an explanation of the approach, area and objectives of the research undertaken.

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

Research Methodology may include brief and concise information on nature of study, research technique adopted, experimental design, sampling method, the statistical methods, the locale of the study, selection of respondents for research/study etc. Author must give period during which the study was conducted. This portion should not be very much lengthy. References for the method used in the study must be cited.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Results and discussion may cover salient outcomes of the study and critical interpretation of the data supported by relevant Tables.

CONCLUSION

The paper must be concluded with a brief note of the results obtained along with their implications in solution of practical problems or contribution to the advancement of the scientific knowledge.

REFERENCES

The list of references must include all published work referred to in the text. References should be arranged alphabetically according to the surnames of the individual authors or first authors. Every reference cited in the paper/article should be included in the list of References. This needs rigorous checking of each reference. Names of authors should not be capitalized. The reference citation should follow the order: author(s), year of publication, title of the paper, name of the periodical, volume and its number; and page number. The list of references should be typed as per the references given in the previous issue.
